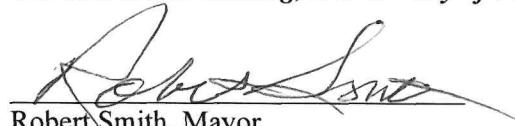
**Relating to Authority of Angelina County Sheriff's Department to Enforce the
Municipal Laws, Rules, and Regulations of the City of Hudson**

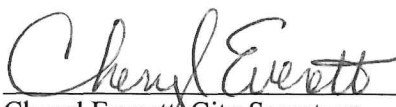
Purpose: An Ordinance of the City of Hudson, Texas authorizing the Angelina County Sheriff's Department to enforce all municipal laws, rules, and regulations of the City of Hudson, in the absence of the existence of a municipal police force and repealing all other ordinances and/or parts of ordinances which may in conflict therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUDSON, TEXAS THAT:

1. Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement by and between the City of Hudson, Texas and the County of Angelina, Texas, the Angelina County Sheriff's Department currently provides all law enforcement and related emergency response services to the citizens of the City of Hudson.
2. By adoption of this Ordinance, and pursuant to its broad enforcement authority granted to the City under Texas Local Government Code Section 54.001, the Angelina County Sheriff's Department and its officials, officers, employees, representatives, and agents, collectively and individually, in their professional capacity, are hereby authorized and granted express permission by the City of Hudson, Texas to enforce any and all municipal laws, rules, regulations, Codes, and ordinances of the City pursuant to its activities under the Interlocal Agreement.
3. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of approval by the City Council; however, to the extent allowed by law and/or necessary to ensure enforcement of all municipal actions, the City Council intends for this authorization to be effective retroactively commensurate with the date of adoption of the Interlocal Agreement with Angelina County.
